We the undersigned Supervisors of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin do certify that the application of six or more freeholders of said town asking for the laying out of certain roads into public highways according to the following survey

to wit: "Commencing in the center of the highway at the quarter stake on the North side of Section 19, Range 12, T. 3; thence S. 8° 15' East one mile and ending as the quarter stake on the South side of Section 19, Range 12, T. 3 said highway to be four rods."

That we caused notices to be posted up in three of the most public places in said town of Janesville, specifying the lands above named proposed for highways and the time and place we would meet to make examination of the same, which notices were posted up at least ten days before said meeting and we do further certify that being fully satisfied that the notices required by law had been given on this 15th day of Feb. 1853 it being the day specified in such notices met at the hour and and place therein named, examined said lands proposed for highways, heard all the reasons for and against laying out the same. We are of the opinion that such highways are necessary and proper and proceeded to lay out the same.

And now we the supervisors in and for the Town of Janesville do on this 15th day of February A.D. 1853 order and declare the above described land to be a public highway, and we do further order the same to be kept open as such pursuant to statute.
