We the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, W.T. have this 21st day of February 1848 discontinued all that part of certain highways or roads in said town hereinafter described to wit: Commencing at a marked tree standing on the line between Sections 5 and 8, T. 3 R. 13 E. on the South side of the Beloit and Fort Atkinson road; thence East on said section line road that runs between said Section 5 and 8 to where said road intersects with the road leading from Janesville to Milton.

Also commencing on the South side of the Beloit and Fort Atkinson road where the section line road that runs between Section 4 & 5, T. 3 N.R. 13 E. intersects with said road; thence South on said section line road to the Janesville and Milton road.

And now we the Commissioners as aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written, order and declare the said road as above described to be hereinafter discontinued as a public highway pursuant to statute in such case made and provided.

A survey made this day of an alteration of a public highway as follows: Commencing at a spotted yellow oak tree between Lots 2 and 3 of Section 14, R. 12 standing in the middle of the road; thence South 58° West 20 chains 19/100's to a post; thence North 55° West 9 chains and 50/100's; thence North 15° East 14 chains and 34/100 to a stake; thence North on the line between the East and West half of the Northwest quarter of Sec. 14 to the Territorial road leading to the Rock River bridge. Said road being three rods wide by order of the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville.
