We the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, W.T. have this 25th day of March A.D. 1848 laid out and established a public highway in said town, an alteration; beginning as follows: At a spotted yellow oak tree between Lots 2 and 3 of Sec. 14, R. 12 standing on or in the middle of the road; thence South 58° W. 20 chains 19 links to a post, thence North 55° W. 9 chains 50/100; thence North 15° E. 14 ch. 34/100 to a stake; thence North on the line between the East and West half of the Northwest quarter of Sec. 14 to the Territorial road leading to the Rock River bridge. Said road being three rods wide.

And now we the Commissioners of aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written, order and declare the read as above described to be a public highway and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.
