Recites in part---it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be, and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to such application. The center of said highway commences at a lime Stone 14 x 5 x 3 inches set in the ground on the centerline of the Janesville and Racine Road near the house of J. P. Wheeler to which point of commencement set witness stones - lime stone 12 x 7 x 4 inches South 30° 50' West 104½ links; running thence South 88° 40' West across the West part of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 5 and across the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 6 both of Town 2 North of Range 13 East 30 chains and 48½ links to a lime stone 11 x 5 x 3 inches set in the ground at the termination of the centerline of a highway running Easterly and Westerly through the estate of Levi St. John to which last mentioned point set witness stones 11 x 6 x 3 inches South 16° 50' West 51¼ links, lime stone 12 x 5 x 3 inches; North 10° 15' West 52¼ links variation of the needle 7° 45' East. Surveyed July 2, 1861.

Recites in part---it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out being described as follows to wit: Beginning at a point in the center of Section 26, Town 2 Range 13 East and running in a Westerly direction on the quarter line to the West line of said section through the center of Section 27 to the quarter stake of 28; thence Westerly on the quarter line of 28 to the Chicago and Northwestern Railway; thence Westerly on the quarter line of said last named section to the public highway that runs North and South along the West line of said Sec. 28. The quarter line to the center of said highway and the same is established four rods wide. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands this 22nd day of July 1859.
