Copy of a Road Order

Recites in part; --- We the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin Territory have this 30 day of September 1845 laid out and established a public highway in said town from the Southeast corner of Section 17, Town 2, Range 13 East on the East side of Section 17, 80 chains, thence North 20° East 80 chains to a point 46 links East of the Southeast corner of Section 5, same town and range; thence North in a line parallel with the East side of Section 17, 534 chains 20 links; thence North 1° 10' West, 45 chains 98 links to a point 46 links West of the Southwest corner of Section 33, Town 3, Range 13. Said road is laid 3 roas wide.

July 19, 1856

Recites---At a meeting of the supervisors of said town agreeable to previous notice, and having examined and deliberated upon the subject herein embraced, it is ordered and determined by said supervisors that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of four rods. The center line of said highway to commence at the Southeast corner of Section 17 and running thence North on the section line between Sections 16 and 17, 8 and 9 and also between said Sections 4 and 5 aforesaid.
