Recites in part---beginning at the quarter section post between Section 23 and 24, Township 2 North of Range 13 East--and running thence from the true meridian North 87° and 30' West, 80 chains to the quarter post between Sections 22 and 23; thence North 89° 45' West, 80 chains to the quarter post between Sections 20 and 21; thence South 89° West, 80 chains to the quarter post between Sections 19 and 20; thence South 88° 30' West, 80 chains to the quarter post on the West line of Sec. 19.

The above survey being the center of said highway --said highway to be four rods wide. And now, therefore, we do order the aforesaid described highway laid out and established. And the same is hereby laid out and established according to the provisions of the statute. In witness whereof we set our hands the day and year above written.

Recites in part---beginning at a certain road running North and South on the section line between 23 and 24 and running West on the half section line of Sections 23, 22 and 21 and so on through the town of so far as the supervisors may think proper. It is hereby order and determined that a highway of the width of four rods, be said and the same is hereby said and established.
