An application in writing bearing date the 22nd of September, 1875 having been made to the Supervisors of said town of Turtle, Rock County, Wisconsin by six and more freeholders residing in the said town for the alteration of a highway in said town and being a portion of a highway which leads East from the town line of said town on the West passing through Section 31 and a part of Section 32 in said town and along the South line of land of Everand Geer and Sarah F. Geer and land of Leonard M. Colt.

And the undersigned having made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which they would meet to decide upon said application and the applicants having considered said notice to be served personally upon each and every one of the occupants of the land through which the said highway as proposed to be altered papers on the 1st day of October, 1875.

And the undersigned having also posted said notice in three public places in the said Town of Turtle on the 30th day of September, 1875 and each and every said notice specified as near as possible the highway proposed to be altered and the several tracts of land through which the same might pass.

And the undersigned supervisors of the said town of Turtle did on the 11th day of October, 1875 at ten o'clock in the forenoon of that day meet at the house of Leonard M. Colt upon the South half of Section 29 and near to the said highway where said alterations was proposed to be made for the purpose of deciding upon the said application - the same being the time and place fixed upon by us and named in the said notice, and we did then and there proceed to examine personally that part of said highway proposed to be altered and after hearing the reasons for and against altering said highway, we did then decide upon said application and determined to alter all that part of said highway, the centerline of which is described as follows (viz):
