At a meeting of the Supervisors of said town agreeable to previous notice and having examined and deliberated upon the subject herein embraced it is ordered and determined by the said supervisors that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of four rods as follows: the center line of the said highway is to commence in the center of the road leading South from the Turtleville Bridge at a point where the center line of Section 9 crosses said road and from that said point running due South on said center line across Section 9, 16, and 21 until it intersects the Milwaukee Road crossing lands owned by John Lewis, H. H. Page, James Billings, Chancy Ross, Russell Harvey, and Philo Porter. The distance not far from two miles.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands at Shopiere this 27<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1855.
