Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said Town of Turtle for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described, we the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 31st day of December A.D. 1859 meet at the house of Hiram Warner in said town for the purpose of decading upon such application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such highway and having heard such reasons as were offered for and against such for laying the same, did decide upon such application and determine to lay out said highway as hereinafter described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused said notice to be duly given to all the occupants of lands through which said highway passes and said notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting, it is ordered and desermined and we do order and determine that a highway be such the same is hereby laid out described as follows: Commencing at the Milwaukee Road on Section 15 where it is intersected by the East 85 of said Section 15; thence running North on said line of said line owned by E. H. Treat and lands unknown and James Billings, Hiram Warner, Alonzo Allen, E. G. Fonda, John P. Fonda, Charles Randall, Jacob F. Dockstader, John McLaughlin until it intersects Shopiere Road as per plat of same, the above named line is the center of said highway and the same is established as four rods in width.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands this 13th day of December. A.D. 1859.
