Beginning 25 links North of the Southwest corner of Sec. 1, T. 3 N., R. 12 E. from thence South 85° W. 12 chains and 50 links to a post, from thence South 65° East 16 chains to a post; from thence South 81° E. 10 chains to a post, from thence South 89° East 20 chains and 13 links to a post; from thence South 86° To chains to the center of the highway Reading from Fulton to the Humes Road, leading from Humes Bridge to Mount Zion.

Said road is laid three rods in width.

And now we the Commissioners aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written, order and declare the road as above described to be a public highway, and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute in such case made and provided.
