DID NOT ACCEPT NOR REJECT THE SET 3/4X24" PIN THAT KREBS PLACED IN 1994. THE PIN IS 2.61' WEST OF THE S 1/4 COR SEC 36 (FD ALUM.)

D) Describe any material discrepancy between the location of the corner as restored or reestablished and the location of that corner as previously restored or reestablished by distance and direction. Show the discrepancy on the plan view drawing under (a), above. Show the distances between the corner as previously restored or reestablished and (1) the corner as restored or reestablished, and (2) to at least 4 of the witness monuments shown on the drawing in (a), above.

AS STATED IN 1983 BARNES VOL 6 PG 308, THE NW COR OF SEC 1 WAS ESTABLISHED BY USING THE ERRONEOUS N 1/4 CORNER OF SEC 2. TOM WOLLIN, JEFFERSON COUNTY SURVEYOR. IN 1985, THE JEFFERSON COUNTY SURVEYOR, WOLLIN REDUG FOR THE S 1/4 COR OF SEC 36 T5N R14E. HE DID NOT FIND THE STONE & ACCEPTED HIS PREVIOUS POSITION FOR THE S 1/4 COR SEC 36. SINCE THE N 1/4 COR OF SEC 1 NEEDS TO BE SET MIDWAY BETWEEN THE NW AND NE CORNERS OF SEC 1, I DID NOT ESTABLISHED THE CORNER BECAUSE THE NW COR SEC 1 WAS ESTABLISHED USING THE ERRONEOUS N 1/4 COR SEC 2. IN 1994 KREBS MAP #9602 SET FOR THE N 1/4 COR SEC 1 A 3/4X24" PIN 2.61' WEST OF S 1/4 COR SEC 36 (FD ALUM.) HIS DISTANCE TO THE NW COR OF SEC 1 INDICATES HE INTENDED TO PLACE THE CORNER MIDWAY BETWEEN THE NW & NE CORNERS OF SEC 1.

THE DEPUTY VISITED THE SITES ON 2/11/03 AND REPORTED THAT THE TERRAIN WAS SUCH THAT AT THE S 1/4 COR SEC 36 THERE WAS A HIGH PROBABILITY THAT THE CUT L.S. SHOULD BE THERE. IN THIS AREA THE ROAD IS IN A FILL AREA. AFTER REVIEWING THE RECORD DISTANCES FROM THE NE COR SEC 1 TO THE CUT L.S. AT THE S 1/4 COR SEC 35, I BELIEVE IT IS POSSIBLE THE STONE MAY BE JUST EAST OF THE PREVIOUS EXCAVATIONS AND IN THE PAVEMENT AREA OR NORTH OF THE PAVEMENT. AT THE SW COR SEC 36, HE REPORTED 3 OF THE 4 SIDES OF THE INTERSECTION WERE HIGHER WITH THE SE INTERSECTION BEING SUBSTANTIALLY LOWER. MORE THAN LIKELY THE ROAD CUT DESTROYED THE CUT L.S.
