

ORDER NUMBER SIX

OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF HIGHWAYS

For a road connecting the road from Beloit to Sugar River with the Monroe Road in Green County.

We Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit met at the dwelling house of Nelson Kinnie in said town, on the 29th day of December A.D. 1845 at eleven o'clock in the forenoon to take into consideration the subject of the petition of John R. Burroughs and fifteen others for a highway to be laid out from the highway from Beloit to Sugar River to the line of Green County in the direction of the Town of Monroe--to interset a road laid out by the County of Green and after it was proved to our satisfaction that notice of our meeting at such time and place had been given us as the law requires -- we proceeded to examine the ground on the line petitioned for and caused a survey of the same to be made as follows:

Beginning at a point in the highway from Beloit to Sugar River bearing North 80° East 5 3/4 chains from the Western most angle post in said highway; thence running N. 61° West 22 chains; thence N. 66 1/2° W. 163.30 chains; thence N. 71 1/4° W. 35 chains; thence N. 59° W. 23 chains to a highway in the County of Green.

And we order and determine that the above described line be the centerline of a highway of four rods in width.

ORDER NO. 1

OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS

For a road running West from West corners of Sections 30 & 31 in Town 1, Range 12.

We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit met this tenth day of March A.D. 1845 at the corners between Sections 25 and 36 of Range 11 and Sections 30 & 31 of Range 12 at nine o'clock in the forenoon and after it was proved to our satisfaction that notice of this meeting was given as the law required--we proceeded to survey the line petitions for as follows:

From the point in the South line of Section 30 where it is crossed by the highway from Beloit to Sugar River to the S.W. corner of said Section 30 is West 5 chains; thence between Sections 25 & 36 is West 80 chains; thence between Sections 27 & 34 to a highway running North on and near the section line through the township is West 8 chains - which line we order and determine shall be the center line of a highway of four rods in width.
