

For road from Beloit to Janesville on range line.

We Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit certify that we met at the North end of Hydraulc Street in the Village of Beloit on the 16th day of January 1846 at nine o'clock in the forenoon for the purpose of taking into consideration the subject of the petition of A. B. Howe and 17 others for a highway to be laid out; thence in a Northeasterly direction to the line between ranges 12 and 13 at a point near Daniel Bennett's house; thence North on the said range line to the North line of Town one.

And being satisfied that notice of our meeting had been given as the law requires by Daniel Bennett, we proceeded to examine the line petitioned for and caused a survey of the same to be made.

And we order that the line petitioned for be the centerline of a highway of four rods in width, described as follows:

Magnetic Variation 6° East. Beginning at the North end of Hydraulc Street and 50 links from its East side; thence running North 34½° East between land owned by Daniel Blodgett and land owned by Woodward and the same course to the line between Range 12 and Range 13, 86.50 chains to a point, 1.60 chains North of the Southeast corner of H. Burchard's land; thence North to the North corners of Section 25 & 30. 22.40 chains

Same to quarter section post 2617.56 39.66 chains

Same to North corners of Section 24 & 19 2603.7 39.45 chains

Same to quarter section post 2620.2 39.70 chains

Same to North corners of Sec. 13 & 18 2610.96 39.56 chains

Same to quarter sec. post bet. Secs. 1 & 6 744 118.70 chains

Same to township corner 5896.5 76.25 chains

Passed at the Annual Meeting in 1846

An act to organize certain towns therein named:

Be it enacted, by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.

Section 5: That Township 1, and the South half of Township 2, North of Range 13, East shall constitute a separate town and shall be known by the name of Turtle.

Section 8: That Township 1 North of Range 10 East, and Township 1 North of Range 11 East, shall constitute a separate town and shall be known by the name of Newark. Approved February 2, 1846.
