

June 19<sup>th</sup> 1851

We the under signed Supervisors of the Town of Fulton as legal and declared to be a public highway a road laid out by Davis Kelly and Warren Sweet on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1843 of which a Survey and plat is recorded, in the town clerks office; described as follows, To wit:  
 Beginning at the angle post standing on a line between Section 20 & 29; thence N. 81° 30' E. bounding the said line 19 ch., 91 links to the corner of Section 20 & 21 28 & 29; thence on the line between Sections 21 & 28 North 81° 30' E. 59 chains 45 links to an angle post; thence S. 63° E. 68°; thence N. 84° E. 49 chains 50 links to the quarter stake between Sections 26 & 27; thence on the line passing through the center of Section 36 N. 82° 15' E. 21 chains 25 links to a burr oak tree; thence N. 76 E. 8 chains 40 links to a white oak thence N. 17° 45" E. 8 chains 50 links to angle post; thence N. 47° 45' E. 7 chains 18 links; thence N. 66° 30' E. 13 chains 10 links intersecting the above mentioned road 29 chains 84 links S. 76 W. of the road leading from Janesville to Lake Koskanong.

The above discription is situated in Town  
4 North Range 12 East.
