The undersigned, Commissioners, appointed by the Legislature of the late Territory of Wisconsin to lay out and establish a Territorial road from Beloit in the County of Rock, thence on the nearest and best route to White Oak Springs in the County of Lagyette Crossing the Pekatonica River at or near the North West Corner of Section 21 T 1,R 6 have laid the said road according to the said Act, that part there of which lies in the Town of Avon County of Rock is located as follows, To Wit: Commencing on the East line of Section 36 T 1, R 10 twenty Chains North of the State line and Eleven miles and five Chains and Eighty five links from the Town of Beloit.

Miles, Chains thence N. 74° W. at 1815 leave Burr Oak barrens and enter Sugar River Marsh 74,15 Chains set a Mile Fost Marked 12 miles: thence continueing on above line 23,50 to angle 10 thence South 54°W 32,25 to angle 11 on left bank of Sugar River. Sugar River at this point is 70 feet wide, 5 feet deep and runs S. E.; thence S. 86° W. 68,25 to angle 12; thence N. 734°W. 80,00 Chains set a mile Post Marked 13M; continuing on above line 31,80 to engle 13 thence N. 86½ W. 80,00 Chains set a mile Post Marked 14M.
