At a meeting of the Supervisors of said town agreeable to previous notice, and having examined and deliberated upon the subject herein embraced, it is ordered and determined by the said Supervisors, that a highway be laid out in said town, of the width of four rods, and have caused a survey thereof to be made, as follows: The center line of the said highway is to commence at the % post on the North line of Section 8 of said Town; thence East on the North line of Section 8 of said Town; thence East on the North line of Section 8 so 53,47 chains to a stake; thence S.54° E 43,60 chains to a stake on the Highway leading from the depot at Edgerton to the Indian Ford, from which a black oak bears S.32° E 26 chains, and a Black Oak S. 40° W 1,02S. and the whole length of the road is one mile 17,07 chains.
