County Surveyor Order No 6 of the Commissioners of Highways for a Road Connecting the Road from Beloit to Sugar River with the Monroe Road in Green County

We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit Met at the house of Nelson Kinney in said town on the 29h day of December AB-1845 at Eleven Oclock in the forenoon to take into consideration the subject of the petition of John R. Burroughs and fifteen others for a highway to be laid from the Highway from Beloit to Sugar River to the line of Green County in the direction of the Town of Monroe to intersect a road laid out by the County of Green and after it was proved to the satisfaction of the Commisshoners that notice of our meeting at such time and place had been given as the law requires we proceeded to examine the ground on the line petitioned for and caused a survey of the same to be made as follows: beginning at a point in the Highway from Beloit to Sugar River bearing North 80° E. 5 Chains from the western most angle post in said Highway thence running North 61° west 22 Chains thence North 66 3/4° W 163,30 Chains; thence N 71%° W 35 Chains thence N 59° W 23 Chains to a Highway in the County of Green. As we order and determine that the above described line be the center line of a Highway of Four Rods in width.
