An Act

TO ORGANIZE CERTAIN TOWNS IN THE COUNTY OF ROCK

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.

1. That township one, and the South half of Township two North, of Range 14 East of the 4th Principal Meridian and Sections 22, 23, 24, 25, 27, 34, 35 & 36 in Township two North of Range 13 East, and Sections 1, 2, 3, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, 35 & 36 in Township two North of Range 13 East, and Sections 1, 2, 3, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, 35 & 36 in Township one North of Range 13 East, be and the same are hereby organized into a separate town, by the name of Clinton.
2. That all that part of Township one North, of Range 13 East, not included in the Town of Clinton, and Section 19, 20, 21, 28, 29, 31, 32, 33 in Township two North of range 13, and Townships one North of Range 10, 11 and 12 East, be, and the same are hereby organized into a separate town, by the name of Beloit; and the first election shall be held at the school house in Beloit.

PROCEEDINGS OF ANNUAL MEETING

At a meeting of the electors of the Town of Beloit held at the district school house pursuant to notice on the fifth day of April A.D. 1842 Hazen Cheeney Esq. was chosen chairman and Edwin Bicknell, Clerk. One motion voted to allow the supervisors of this town \$6 per day for their services for doing business while in town and one dollar per day when called out. One motion voted that all officers except Treasurer and Collector be allowed for their services \$6 per day.

One motion voted to allow the Treasurer of this town one percentum on all moneys put into his hands.

Voted to set the office of Collector up at Auction and the one that will give the most to the Town out of the five per cent allowed by law shall have the office. Bid off by Henry Mears at four percent. Voted at this time that this meeting stand pledged to support the man for chairman of the board of supervisors who will pay the most to the town out of the two dollars per day allowed him by law for services in said office.

Bid off by Selvy Kidder at one dollar per day. Voted to adjourn to this place at one o'clock. One o'clock P.M. set according to adjournment. One motion voted to elect one Constable in this town for the ensuing year.

Also voted to elect one assessor in this town for the ensuing year.
