

Whereas upon the application of 11 freeholders residing in said town of Porter for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described, we the undersigned Supervisors of said town did on the fourth day of December 1868, meet at the new Bridge over the Catfish River on Section 13 in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon said application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose and for sufficient reason we there adjourned to meet at the house of Ephraim F. Sayer on said action forthwith and being assembled at said house we then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the said highway and a sever snow storm prevailing; we adjourned to meet at the said house of Ephraim F. Sayre on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of December at 9:00 A.M.

At which time having met we did proceed to examine personally such highway and we did then and there decide upon said application and determined to lay out such highway as hereinafter is described. Having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our first meeting as herein before mentioned caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before our said meeting. It is ordered and determined and we do here by order and determine that a highway be and is hereby laid out pursuant to said application whereof an accurate survey has been made, which is as follows, to wit: Beginning at the quarter Post of Section line between Sections 11 & 12 Town 4 and Range 11; thence South on said line 40 chains to the South East corner of Section 11; thence S. 14° E. 11.90 chains to a stake; thence S. 34° E. 14.75 chains to a stake; thence S. 80° W. 2 chains; thence S. 40° W. 3.50 chains; thence S. 7° E. 3 chains; thence S. 46° E. 4.25 chains; thence S. 45° W. across the Catfish River 6.31 chains to a point on the East and west quarter line on Section 14, 89 links West of the quarter post between Section 13 and 14. The line of said Survey to be the center of said highway. The same is established 4 rods in width and we the Supervisors undersigned having made such order and laid out said Highway as aforesaid and having agreed with certain occupants of the lands through which said Highway passes as to amount of damages to be paid said persons to wit: Foster J. Jessup and Elizabeth K. Wallin and Ephraim F. Sayre.

Now therefore it is agreed between the said Supervisors and the said Foster J. Jessup, Elizabeth K. Wallin and Ephraim F. Sayre, that the damages sustained by the parties by reason of the laying out and opening said highway on their several lands be liquidated and agreed upon as follows:
