

Order for Laying a Road May 10th 1855

We the undersigned Supervisors of the town of Fulton in the County of Rock and State of Wisconsin do hereby certify that we on the application of six or more freeholders and residents of said town asking for the laying out of a public highway in said town caused notice to be posted up in three of the most public places in the said town fixing therein the time when&the place when we would meet to decide upon the aforesaid application and also specifying as near as practible the road proposed to be laid out and the several tracts of land through which the same might pass which notices were posted up at least ten days before the time therein fixed for said meeting and we do further certify that being fully satisfied that all the notices required by law to be given to occupants were given pursuant to statute, we on this tenth day of May A.D. 1855 it being the specified time in said notices for said meeting, met the hours and place there mentioned and proceeded personally to examine said proposed Highway, heard all the reasons for and against laying out the same and decided that said proposed highway was necessary and proper and we do further certify that therefore we caused an accurate survey to be made of said proposed Highway which survey is as follows to wit: Beginning in the center of the public highway running seven chains from the East end of the Bridge over the Catfish River; thence North sixty three degrees E. 141 Chains; thence 13° W. 5 chains; thence 26° E. 49 chains 55 links to the center of a road on the North line of Section 18 3 chains 86 links from the N.E. corner of said Section, and now therefore we the Supervisors aforesaid in and for said town of Fulton do on this 10th day May S.D. 1855 order and declare the above described road to be a public highway four rods wide and we do further order the same to be opened and kept open as such pursuant to Statute.

In witness whereof we the Supervisors aforesaid have hereunto set our hands this 10th day of May A.D. 1855.
