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Supervisors Order No. 1

We the Supervisors in and for the Town of Avon met this 28th day of June A.D. 1849 at the Store of Joseph Kinney in said Town to examine the subject of the petition of Ira Hersey and 7 others for the alteration of a Highway running through said Town running on the South line of Sections 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 the alteration of said Road commences at a point 26 chains West of the $\frac{1}{4}$ Post on the South side of Section 17: thence running South 26 degrees West three chains and 74 links: thence South 79 degrees West 12 Chains and 50 links to Sugar River the width of the River is 80 feet: thence South 87 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 18 Chains to where it intersects the Road that is now laid, and we Order and determine that the above described line be the center line of a Highway four rods in width. We also order that the old route between the points specified be discontinued. Witness our hands.
