At a meeting of the Supervisors of said town agreeable to previous notice and having examined and deliberated upon the subject herein embraced it is ordered and determined by the said Supervisors that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of four rods and have caused a survey thereof to be made as follows: Commencing on the South line of section 28 eighty rods West from the South East corner of said Section: thence running East on the Section line 80 rods to the Section corner thence South 4 rods thence East 40 rods thence a Southeasterly course to the East line of the North West quarter of the North West quarter of Section 34 at a point 56 rods South of the North line of said Section thence South on the line of eighty to the State Line.
