ORDER OF HIGHWAY

Rock County ss.
Town of Beloit

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Beloit for the laying out of a highway herein described we the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 29th day of November 1859 meet at the house of Abraham Jarvis - in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose. Did there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the same, did then and there decide upon such application and determine to lay out said highway as hereinafter described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed thereon a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application - and the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notices to be duly given to all occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days
