

Order for discontinuing a Highway--Town of Fulton

Whereas upon applicatin of six freeholders residing in the said town of Fulton for the discontinuance of a highway as follows: Beginning at a point in the North and South highway on Section 18 in said town between the Catfish River and Mill Race at the Village of Fulton in said town and thence running in a N.W. direction to the West line of the said town of Fulton. we the undersigned Supervisors of said town did on the 3rd day of Aug. 1883 make a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet on the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of Aug. 1883 at 3 o'clock in the afternoon of said day at the Town Clerks office in the Village of Fulton it being the time and place fixed by us in said notice; and having first been satisfied by due proof that the notice aforesaid had been duly given five days previous to the time of our said meeting to all the occupants of the lands through which such highway by serving each of them personally with such or by copy thereof left with or at the ususal place of abode of each occupant of said lands and had also been posted up in three public places in said town ten 10 days before the time of our said meeting in the manner required by law, we did then and there proceed to examine personally said highway, and did hear any and all reasons that were offered for or against discontinuing the same, did decide upon such application and it being our opinion that the public good will thereby be promoted did decide to discontinue such highway hereafter described.

Beginning at a point on the North and South highway on Sec.18 in the said town between the Catfish River and Mill Race at the Village of Fulton in said town and thence running in a north-westerly direction to the West line of said town (known as the road across the dam)

Now therefore persuant to said application we, the said Supervisors do hereby order and determine that said highway above discribed be and the same is hereby discontinued.
