

We the undersigned Supervisors of the town of Avon in the County of Rock and Supervisors of the town of Spring Grove, in the County of Green, having by an order bearing date the 20th day of February, A.D. 1864. Signed by the Supervisors of Spring Grove and signed the 17th day of March 1864 by the Supervisors of Spring Grove upon due application for that purpose, laid out a joint highway as follows: Commencing on the County line between the Counties aforesaid at the South West Corner of the North West quarter of Section number 30 in Township 1 North of Range number 10 it being also the South east corner of the North East quarter of Section number 25 in Township number one North of Range number nine East; thence North in said County line between the Counties aforesaid to the North West corner of Section number 18 in Township number 1 North of Range 10 being also the North East corner of Section number 13 in Township number 1 North of Range number nine East, said County line being the center of said highway, and the same is established four rods in width, and certain owners of land through which said highway is laid out, to wit ; we did proceed to assess the damages which such owners would sustain by reason of the laying out of such highway.
