

Whereas upon an application of six freeholders residing in said town of Avon for the laying out and establishing of a highway herein after described. We the undersigned Supervisors of said town of Avon did on the 18th day of May 1860 meet at the House of Elizah Adams upon said application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard reasons as were offered for and against laying out and establishing the same did then and there decide upon such application and determine to lay out and establish said highway as herein after described. Having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicants for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands, through which said Highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting. It is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a Highway be and the same is hereby laid out and established pursuant to said application thereof an accurate survey has been made as follows to wit:

Commencing at thr center on the East line of Section 30 as established by government survey and running West on the line of said Government Survey untill it intersects the line running North and South siad line being the boundary between Rock and Green Counties the line of said survey to be the center of said Highway and the same is established four rods in width.
