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Whereas upon application of six freeholders residing in said Town of Fulton for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described we the undersigned supervisors of said town did met at the house an residence of Elvi Gosline in said town of Fulton on the 28th day of June A.D. 1862 that being the time and place fixed by us for the purpose of deciding on said application did adjourn said meeting held for the purpose aforesaid to the 6th day of October A.D. 1862 at 10 o'clock A.M. which last named meeting was also adjourned to the 14 day of October at 10 o'clock at the same place and time and we did at the last named date proceed to examine personally such highway and having then heard such reasons as were offered for or against laying out such highway did there and then decide upon such application and determine to lay out said highway as hereinafter described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the application having five days previous to our said meeting first named caused the notice to be dully given to all of the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of such first meeting. It is ordered & determined and we do hereby order & determine that a highway be, the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application whereof an actual survey has been made which is as follows to wit: Commencing at a point fifty two rods East of the North & South centerline of Section 32 of said town of Fulton; thence due South through the lands of Thomas T. Furling 69 rods; thence due South on the line between Louisa Darotts land & luke Stoughtens lands; thence due South across the land of Elvi Gosline to the South line of said township so as to meet & _____ a line surveyed through the lands of Brace in the town of Janesville for a highway the line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established four rods in width.
