

Order for laying out a Highway on the town line between the towns of Fulton & Janesville January 25th 1866.

Whereas upon the application of six freeholder residing in the town of Janesville & upon the petition of six freeholders of the town of Fulton for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described as we the undersigned Supervisors of said towns of Janesville & Fulton did on the 25th day of January 1866 meet at the house of Jesse Cross in said town of Janesville for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the place by us fixed for that purpose; did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for & against laying out the same did then & there decide upon such application & determine to lay out said highway as hereinafter described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time & place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicants for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be dually given to all the occupants of the lands through which such highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in each of said towns ten days before our said meeting. It is ordered & determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be & the same is hereby laid out pursuant to such application whereof an accurate survey has been made which is as follows to wit: Commencing at the North East corner of Section one of the town of Janesville and in the center of the Highway running between the towns of Janesville & Harmony running thence west on the North line of said Section 1 (1) one mile to the center of the Highway running between sections 1 & 2 in said town of Janesville. The line of said survey to be the center of said highway which line is the town line between the towns of Fulton & Janesville and the same is established four rods in width; two rods on each side of said line. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands this 25th of January 1866.
