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Survey of a Road to discontinue a part of a road in the Town of Fulton made Feb. 3 A.D. 1846. Beginning at the ¼ on the South line of Section 5 Town 4 North Range 12 East, thence S.1° E. 46 chains, thence S. 32° E. 75,25 chains to a point on the East line of Section 17,10.04 chains North of the ¼ Post. The whole length of road to discontinue is 1 mile 41.25 chains.

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A Survey of an altered road made this 2nd day of May 1846. By order of the commissioner of highways of the Town of Fulton. Beginning 1 chain 35 links North of the 14 post between Section N. 35 & 36 Town 4 North Range 12 East from thence North 8° W. 24 chains 91 links to a post standing in the center of the Highway leading Northerly to Goodrich's Ferry. This Road is laid four rods wide by order of the commissioners of Highways of the Town of Fulton.

Fulton May 2nd 1846 E. C. Storey -surveyor We the Commissioners of Highways for the Township of Fulton do this day lay out and establish the above survey as a public Highway four rods wide, the section line being the center of the same. Emanuel Cawker - Orson Cox -Commissioners of Highway

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We the Commissioners of Highways for Fulton Townshipdo this day "lay out and establish" a public highway in said township. Beginning at the quarter section post on the south side of section 33 in Town 4 North of Range 12 East, and running North between between the East and West half of said section 33,55 chains & 8 links to the County Road running Easterly from Foster's Ferry; thence North 88° 45" west 19 chains & 83 links along the center of the County Road sforesaid, to the line between the East & West helf of the North West quarter of said Section 33; thence North on said line last named 24 chains & 50 links, thence North between the East & West half of the South West quarter of Section 28, 39 chains & 80 links to a stake on the East & west center line of Section 28 of (Fulton Township) seid stake being 80 rods or one eighth of the width said section 28 East from the west line thereof. From this to a stake in the center of the road leading from Milton Township to the Indian Ford on Rock River. We the said Commissioners of Highways do agree to adopt a survey made under the direction of the Commissioners of Highways of Fulton Township by Harrison Stebbins County Surveyor April 18m A.D. 1844 of an alteration of a road as follows.

Beginning at a stake on the center of the road leading from the town of Milton to the Indian Ford on Rock River which stake is 89 links North of a point 20 chains west of the 14 post on the North line of S. 21, T. 4 N. R. 12 E.,
