

We the Supervisors of Porter upon application duly considered have ordered and directed the following survey of a road to be made. Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ post on the section line between Section 11 & 12 T. 4 R. 11; thence South on the line 40.00 chains to S.E. corner of S. 11; thence S. $15\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 11.90 to a *WALL IN* stake; thence S. 6° W. 10.14 chains to Black Oak on bank of Spring Brook; thence S. 5° E. 13.75 to the Catfish River; thence S. 47. W. 3.54 chains to center of a road on the E. & W. center line of Section 14, 236 chains west of the $\frac{1}{4}$ post on the East line of Section 14; thence N. on said center line 17.14 chains to a point 50 links East of the line that divided the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 14; thence South parallel with and 50 links from the line dividing the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14 and the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, 80.00 chains intersecting the road running E. & W. through Section 23 and the whole length of the road is 2 miles 18.47 chains. The courses are given according to the true meridian, variation of needle 8° . *Caladonia*

We the said supervisors do hereby declare the above described route to be a public Highway four rods wide.

RAYMOND RD

We the Supervisors of Porter upon application duly considered have ordered and directed the following survey of a road to be made. Beginning 50 links South of the N.W. corner of Section 3 T. 4 R. 11 in the center of a road running North & South past the house of James White and on the line between Section 3 & 4; thence East parallel with the North line of Sec. 3, 61.00 Chains to a stake; thence S. $4\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 12.52 chains to small Burr Oak tree; thence S. 39° E. 27.30 chains to E. & W. $\frac{1}{4}$ line of S. 2; thence E. on said line 15.56 chains to the center of Sec. 2; thence East on said line and on the E. & W. $\frac{1}{4}$ line of Section 1, 120.00 chains to the town line and the whole length of road hereby laid according to the above survey is three miles 14.93 chained. The courses are given according to the true meridian.

The variation of Needle 8° Survey made Feb. 28th A.D. 1857

We the Supervisors do hereby declare the above described road to be a public Highway four rods wide the line surveyed being the center of the same.
