

Order for laying Highway

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Fulton for the laying out of a highway as herein-after described, we the undersigned Supervisors of said town did on the 30th day of Nov. 1876, make out a notice and fix there in a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet on the 12th day of Dec. 1876, at two o'clock in the P.M. of said day at the house of Patrick Quigley in said town, it being the time and place fixed by us in said notice, and having first been satisfied that the notice aforesaid had been duly given five days previous to the time of our said meeting, to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes, and had also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting in the manner required by law; we did then and there proceed to examine personally said highway and did hear all reasons that were offered for or against laying out the same, and did decide upon such application, and it being our opinion that the public good will thereby be promoted, did decide to layout said highway as hereinafter described.

Now therefore, pursuant to said application, we, the said supervisors do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out as follows, to wit: Commencing three rods South of South quarter stake of Section 2 of the town of Fulton, Rock County Wis.; and one and $\frac{1}{2}$ rods West of said quarter line; thence North on lands of James Welch, John Sherman and Patrick Quigley, 83 rods to highway and one and $\frac{1}{2}$ rods west of a parallel with said quarter line said line being the center of said highway, which is laid out 3 rods wide.
