

Order for laying out a Road May 10<sup>th</sup> 1855

We the undersigned Supervisors of the town of Fulton and County of Rock and State of Wisconsin do hereby certify that we on the application of six or more freeholders and residents of the said town asking for the laying out of a public highway in said town caused notice in writing to be posted up in three of the most public places in said town fixing therein the time when and the place when we would meet to decide upon the aforesaid application and also specifying as near as practicable the road, proposed to be laid out and the several tracts of land through which the same might pass; which notice were posted up at least ten days before the time therein fixed for said meeting and we do further certify that being fully satisfied that all the notices required by law to be given to occupants were given pursuant to statute. We on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1855 it being the specified time in said notice for said meeting met the hour and place therein mentioned and proceeded personally to examine such proposed highway heard all the reasons for and against laying out the same and decided that said proposed road was necessary and proper. We do further certify that thereupon we caused an accurate survey to be made of the said proposed highway which survey is as follows to wit: Beginning at the S.E. Corner of Sec. 16; thence running west on said line two hundred and twenty rods to a street running N. and S. by Dr. Guy Roughtons\* house and now therefor we the Supervisors aforesaid in and for said town of Fulton do on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1855 order and declare the above described road to be a public highway four rods wide and we do further order the same to be opened and kept open as such pursuant to Statute.
