Order for Laying a Road February 16th A.D. 1854

We the Supervisors, undersigned of the town of Fulton County of Rock and State of Wisconsin, do hhereby certify that we on the application of six or more freeholders and residents of said town asking for the laying out of a public highway in said town, caused notices in reiting to be posted up in three of the most public places in said town, fixing therein the time when and the place when we would meet to decide upon the aforesaid application, and also specifying therein as near as practicable the road proposed to be laid out and the several tracts of land through which the same might pass, which notices were posted up at least ten days before the time fixed therein for said meeting. And we do further certify that being fully satisfied that all the notices required by law to be given to applicants; occuppants were given prusuant to Statute, we on this 16th day of February A.D. 1854, it being the specified time in said notices for said meeting, met at the hour and place there named and proceeded personally to examine said proposed road heard all the reasons for and against laying out the same, and decided that said proposed highway was necessary and proper, and we do further certify that there upon, we caused an accurate survey of said proposed highway to be made which survey is as follows, to wit: Beginning on the quarter quarter line of the North West quarter of Section four (4) of town four (4) North, of Range Twelve (12) East, on the North line of Rock County; thence running S. 26% E. 25.10 chains; thence S. 57% E. 35.50 chains; thence S. 50° E. 12,10 chains; thence N. 85° E. 20.00 chains to a public road on the East line of Section four (4) in said town; the above courses and distances being the center line of said proposed road.

And now therefore, we the Supervisors aforesaid in and for the town of Fulton, do on this 16m day of February A.D. 1854, order and declare the above described highway to be a public highway four rods wide and we do further order the same to be opened and kept open as such pursuant to Statute.
