whereas upon the application of 6 free holders residents of the town of Forter for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described we the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 28th day of September A.D. 1867 meet at the house of Jeremiah McCarthy on the North half of the North East quarter of section 5 in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose; did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for or against laying out the same did then there decide upon such application and determine to lay said highway as hereinafter described having as required by law; first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the application for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and such notice having been posted up in three public places in said town ten days previous to our said meeting and that the said Supervisors in connection with the undersigned supervisors fo the town of Dunkirk in the county of Dane, and being satisfied that the law in all respects has been complied with it is hereby ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that said highway be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application; described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the North East corner of Dection 5 in the town of Porter and at the South East corner of Section 32 in the town of Dunkirk, Dane County; thence running west on said line until near the corner of Mr. Savages Orchard. Said Orchard being on the South East quarter of Section 31 in said town of Dunkirk; thence bearing South 2 rods; thence west until it intersects the Cookville and Dunkrk road running North and South on the centerline of Section 6 in Forter and the North and wouth centerline of Section 31 in Bunkirk, Bane County.

The said highway is laid out on the North line of Section 5 and on the Northline of Section 6 until it reaches the North West corner of the N.E.W of said Section 6 intersecting the road running from Cookville to Dunkirk bearing South 2 rods opposite J.A. Savages Orchard and the whole length of said road being one and one half miles (1%) more or less the line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established 4 rods

in width.
