Order for Laying out Highway- Fulton Township

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said Town of Fulton for the laying out of highway as hereinafter described, we the undersigned Supervisors of said town of Fulton did on the 2nd day of May 1885 make out a notice and fix a time therein and a place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet on the 13th day of May 1885 at Gvelochs in the forenoon on that day at the office of the Town Clerk of said town, it being the time and place fixed by us, in said notice and having first been satisfied, that the notice aforesaid had been duly given five days previous to the time of our said meeting, to all the occupants of the lands, through which said proposed road passed and had also been posted in three public places in said Town in the manner prescribed by law, ten days previous to the time of our said meeting, we did then and there proceed to examine personally, said proposed Highway, and there being no reasons offered against said proposed highway and of laying out the same, we did decide upon such application and it being our opinion that the public good would be promoted thereby did decide to layout said highway, as herein-after described. Now therefore pursuant to said application, we the said Supervisors of said Town of Fulton do hereby order and determine that a road or highway be and the same is hereby laid out as follows; Commencing at a point on the North side of Section 21, on the Section line between Section 16 and 21 T. 4 R. 12 N. Rock County, Wisconsin where there is a lime stone set in the ground with four small coble stones, one on each side of it; said point is ninety eight (98) rods and 8 links West from the quarter post on the North line on said Section 21; thence running South and little West through lands owned by I. Bleasson parallel with present road to Franklin Street, through lot 1 Block 7 until said road intersects with Water Street, angling South West across Franklin Street, to where said road intersects with said Water Street taking a triangular piece of land off of Section 1 Block 7 from its North West corner of said lot, 20 links on North line from North West corner and three rods and 8 links on West side, South from North West corner of said lot to where a lime stone is set in the ground in said Water Street said stone being 7 by 12 inches, and said described line being the center of said highway and said highway being the center of said highway and said highway being 4 rods wide.
