The said town line is the center of said highway, and the same is laid out of the width of three rods and we do further order and determine that the following described part of said highway to wit: The last half shall be made and kept in repair by the town of Fulton and the residue thereof by the town of Janesville, and that the damages agreed upon with the owner of the following described lands to wit: The North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section 3 in the town of Janesville shall be paid by the town of Fulton. Made and signed by us this 22nd day of March 1871

Whereas upon the application of more than six freeholders of said town of Fulton for the laying out of a highway as herein after described, we the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 3rd day of March A.D. 1871. Make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, and did meet on the 18th day of March 1871, at ten o'clock in the forenoon of said day at the house of Robert wiley in said town, it being the time and place fixed by us and in said notice, and having been first satisfied that the notice aforesaid had been duly given five days previous to the time of our said meeting to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and had also been posted up in the three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting in the manner required by law. We did then and there proceed to examine personally said highway and did hear all reasons that were offered, for and against laying out the same and did decide upon such application and it being our opinion that the public good will be thereby promoted did decide to lay out said highway as hereinafter described: Now therefore pursuant to said application we the said Supervisors do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out as follows to wit: Beginning at a point on the line between the East half and the west half of the North West quarter of Section 34 in sais town of Fulton where the highway running northerly and Southerly through the North part of said North West quarter intersects the highway running Easterly and Westerly through said North West quarter and running thence Southerly on the line between said East half and said West half of said North West quarter and on the line seperating the lands of A.B. Burlingame and C.S. Lunn to the North line of the South West quarter of said section 34 then continuing in the same southerly course through the land of R. Wiley to the South line of said Section 34 terminating at the South East corner
