whereas upon the application of six freeholders, residing in said town of Porter for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described, we the undersigned supervisors of said town, did on the 28th day of September A.D. 1867 meet at the house of Jeremiah McCarthy in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application, it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose, did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the same, did then and there decide upon such application and determine to lay said highway as hereinafter described; having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting, caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the land through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town, ten days before the time of our said meeting and that the aforesaid Supervisors in connection with the undersigned Supervisors of the town of Dunkirk in the County of Dane, having been satisfied that the law has in all respects been complied with; it is hereby ordered and determined, and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application: described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the N.E. Corner of Section 5 in said town of Porter, on the town line between said town and the town of Dunkirk (Dunkirk being in the County of Dane) and thence running west on said line until it intersects Mr. Savages orchard (said orchard being in the South West corner of Section 31 in the town of Dunkirk Dane County, thence bearing South 2 rods; thence west to the Cookville and Dunkirk road running South on the center line of Section 6 in Porter, the said highway is laid out running through the North half of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5 and the N. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5 also the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6 in the town of Porter, the whole length of the road being one and one half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) miles more or less. The line of said survey to be the center of said highway; and the same is established four rods in width.
