To Wm. Key thirty dollars damages and to George Ramsey forty dollars damages and to James Caldwell ten dollars damages to be paid equally by both Towns. Town of Fulton to pay George R. Ramsey forty dollars, Town of Janesville to pay Wm. W. Key thirty dollars and James Caldwell ten dollars; and we do further certify that the Town of Janesville shall keep in repair the East half of said Highway and the Town of Fulton the west half of said Highway.

Survey of a Road in the town of Fulton, Rock County made Oct. 25<sup>th</sup>  
1852

Beginning in the center of a public road in the East & West quarter line of Sec. 9 town four North of Range 12 East, 5 chains 38 links West of the center post in said section; thence S. 1° 15' West 95 chains 75 links to a point in the center of a Street in the Village plat of the Indian Ford; thence along the center of said street S. 30° W. 18 chains 81 links to an angle of said street. thence S. 70° W. in said street 5 chains, intersecting a public highway. Whole distance 119 chains 56 links.

We the Supervisors of the Town of Fulton have this October 25<sup>th</sup> 1852 laid out and established a public highway according to the above survey and declare the same to be a public highway 4 rods wide.
