At a meeting of the Supervisors of the towns of Fulton and Albion, the said supervisors of the town of Albion and two of the supervisors of the town of Fulton having met and deliberated on the subject of this order, it is ordered and determined by the said supervisors that a highway be laid out on the town line of Albion & Fulton 4 rods wide. and the said supervisors have caused a survey to be made thereof as follows: The center line of the said highway is to commonce at the center of the highway running North and South near the house of Benjamin F. Collins and at the quarter post on the South line of Section 32 Town 5 North of Range 12 East; thence East on the Section line 120 chains to the South Bast Corner of Section 33, Town 5 North of Range 12 East; thence East on the Section line 120 chains to the South East Corner of Section 33, T. 5 R. 12 E. thence North 78° East 10 chains to a burr Oak 12 inches in dismiter marked A.; thence South 68°E. 3.75 chains to a Burr Oak 12 inches in dismeter standing on said Sec. line; thence E. on said line 146 chains to the S.E. corner of Section 35; thence Last on said line 4.10 to the center of the highway leading from Albion to Goodrich's Bridge on Rock River. The whole length of the highway is 3 miles 43.85 chains, courses given according to the true meridian, variation of Needle 7 374° and it is further ordered and determined that the west half of said highway be made and kept in repair by the town of Albion and the Bast half of said highway shall be made and kept in repair by the town of Fulton. And it is further determined that the town of Albion shall pay one half of all damages caused by laying said highway and that the town of Fulton shall pay half of all damages in consequince of the laying said highway. It is further determined by the said supervisors to offer and we do by these present, offer as damages by reason of the laying out said highway to the following persons the following sums of money to wit: Avin Burdick who is now in possession of lands lying on said highway, Five Dollars. To Jay Humphrey, five dollars and to Luke Coom five dollars.
