Order for Laying out a Road March 28th 1853

We the Supervisors of the town of Fulton Rock County. Wis. do certify that upon the application of six or more freeholders asking for the laying of a Public Highway in the Town of Fulton to wit: Commencing.50 chains East of the East end of Stones Bridge Fulton; thence S.6° %. 9.50 chains; thence S. 18° East 26 chains; thence S. 58° East 7 chains; thence S. 30° East 15 chains; thence S. 23° East 5 chains; thence S. 35° East 5.75 chains; thence S. 40° East 7.66 chains; thence S. 50° East 11.50 chains; thence S. 76%° East 5.25 chains; thence N. 82° East 7 chains; thence S. 18° East 20.35 chains intersecting the Fublic Road between lots numbered five and six on fractional section thirty one:

That we caused notice be be posted in writing in three of the most . public places in said town of Fulton specifying the road above named proposed for a highway, and the time and place at which we would meet to make examination of the same which notice were passed up at least ten days before said meeting and we do further certify that being fully satisfied, that the notices required by law had been given pursuant to Statute; we on this 284 day of March A.D. 1853 is being the specified time in said notice, met at the hour and place therein named examined and caused a survey to be made of the said proposed Highway, heard all the reasons for and against laying out the same and we are of the opinion that such Highway is necessary and proper and proceeded to lay out the same: And now therefore we the Supervisors aforesaid in an for the Town of Fulton do on this 28m day of March 1853 order and declare the above described Road to be a Public Highway four rods wide, and we do further order and declare the same to be kept open as such pursuant to Statute. And we do further certify that we have assessed the damages as follows; to wit: Elijah True 35.00, fifteen dollars to be paid, by the Town of Fulton.
