<u>Approval of Agenda.</u> Supervisors Fox and Bussie moved the agenda, deleting item 9b concerning an easement across the Pelishek Tiffany Nature Trail. MOTION CARRIED.

<u>Election of Vice-Chair.</u> Supervisors Arnold and Fox nominated Supervisor Bussie. Chair Yankee called for more nominations three times. Supervisors Fox and Arnold moved to close the nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Supervisor Bussie as Vice-Chair. MOTION CARRIED.

<u>Set Meeting Day and Time.</u> Supervisor Fox asked that the meetings begin at 8:00 a.m. instead of 8:30 a.m. Supervisors Fox and Arnold moved to keep meeting days the same and change the start time from 8:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. MOTION CARRIED.

<u>Approval of Minutes of April 10, 2012.</u> Supervisors Arnold and Brown moved the minutes. MOTION CARRIED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications, and Announcements.</u> Ben Coopman stated Corporation Counsel is available to speak to any committee member about the citizen participation aspect of the meeting.

Supervisor Bussie stated she was very pleased to have Supervisor Brown on this committee.

Chair Yankee also welcomed new committee member, Dave Brown.

Minutes of the Rock County Public Works Committee May 8, 2012

<u>Public Hearing on Park Draft Master Plans (DMP) for Carver-Roehl and Magnolia Bluff</u>
<u>County Parks.</u> Andrew Bremer discussed the creation of both park plans starting with an online survey that was conducted last summer.

Kevin Kawula spoke about the plans and what it does not include:

His three main points were:

- 1) Inaccurate and incomplete State Natural Area designation and mapping will leave Magnolia Bluff susceptible to continued harmful land management practices by Public Works & Parks. No DMP should go forward without accurate maps and natural area surveys.
- 2) Proposed "New Trail Construction" should be removed as it will lead to fragmentation, habitat loss, erosion, and would publicly, through Public Works & Parks, perpetuate historical inaccuracies surrounding the "Ice Age Trail" and Magnolia Bluff's significance during the Wisconsin Era Glaciation.
- 3) The recommendation to bring electricity to Magnolia Bluff should be removed from the DMP until proper Environmental Impact Studies can be conducted, and a more sustainable less invasive solution can be reached for park users requesting amenities.

Extensive discussion took place on the aforementioned and other related items. Supervisor Brown spoke in favor of including a couple of paragraphs regarding the endangered species of flora and fauna at Magnolia Bluff County Park. He does not feel the plan needs to be redesigned. Adding an appendix was discussed. More discussion.

Tom Presny expressed his admiration for Kevin's commitment. We need to think about what we are doing. Kevin's knowledge is rare and his commitment is rare. Tom looks at a plan as a starting point. It is a guide. We want the best possible outcome.

Ben Coopman agrees with Tom Presny. This is a passive recreational area. It sounds like Kevin and others want to turn this into a restoration area – a great change of scope.

Discussion on electricity at the park took place. Substitution Record wants of the park agraphs from Keylin Kawula or menaging the SNA areas to be included in the plan.

Kevin Kawula agreed to provide information for the appendix to the plan on endangered species at the park. He will forward the information to the Parks Division.

Nancy Pope commented on the DMP for Carver Roehl Park. She stated everyone is excited about getting a hand pump installed by the pavilion. No one was excited about having a bike rack – they felt it did not fit in. They liked the idea of stepping stones in the creek. They were not in favor of removing the red pines.

Written comments were submitted by Kevin Kawula, Angel Kubly, Suzie Smith and Randy Hoffman concerning Magnolia Bluff Park and are on file at the Parks Division office.
