

ORDER FOR HIGHWAY

County of Rock ss.  
Town of Beloit

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Beloit in said county; and six freeholders residing in the adjoining Town of Newark in said county for the laying out of a highway commencing at the Northeast corner of Sec. 12 in the Town of Newark and the Northwest corner of Section 7 in the Town of Beloit; and running thence due South on the town line until it intersects the Beloit and Madison Road; thence to terminate or as near thereto as the situation of the ground will admit. We the undersigned supervisors of said towns did on the 20th day of May A.D. 1876 make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon the application and did meet on the 3rd day of June A.D. 1876 at 2 o'clock in the afternoon at the house of James Whitehead in Sec. 12 in the Town of Newark, it being the time and place fixed by us in said notice. And having first been satisfied that the notice aforesaid had been duly given five days previous to the time of our said meeting to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes, and had also been duly posted up in three public places in each of said towns, ten days before the time of our said meeting. We did proceed to examine personally such highway and having heard all reasons that were offered for or against the laying out the same, did decide upon such application, and deeming it necessary did then and there determine to lay out said highway as hereinafter described.

Now therefore, pursuant to said application we the said supervisors do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out as follows to wit: Commencing at the Northeast corner of Sec. 12 in the Town of Newark and the Northwest corner of Section in the Town of Beloit; and running thence DUE SOUTH on the town line until it intersects the Beloit and Madison Road. Then to terminate of distance running 39 rods said highway to pass through or on a part of the N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 12, in the Town of Newark and the N.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 7 in the Town of Beloit all in the County of Rock and State of Wisconsin.

The same being an accurate survey caused by us to be Made and said highway being upon or as near thereto as the situation of the ground will admit the town line between said towns. The line of said survey is the center of said highway and the same is laid out of the width of four rods to reach to and intersect the said Madison and Beloit Road. And we do further order and determine that the following described part of said highway to wit:

The North half of said highway to be made and kept in repairs by the Town of Newark and the residue thereof by the Town of Beloit and that the damages awarded to the owners of the following described lands: N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 12 in the Town of Newark and the N.W. 1/4 of the W. 1/4 of Section 7 in the Town of Beloit. The damages awarded to the owners shall equally be divided and paid by said town.

DAMAGES FOR HIGHWAY

County of Rock ss.  
Town of Beloit

We, the undersigned supervisors of the Towns of Newark and Beloit in the County of Rock having by our order bearing date the 3rd day of June A.D. 1876 upon due application for that purpose laid out a highway as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of Section 12 in the Town of Newark and the Northwest corner of Section 7 in the Town of Beloit and running from thence due South on the town line until it intersects the Beloit and Madison Road, then to terminate and the following named owners of lands through which said highway is laid not having released all claim to damages sustained by reason of the laying out and opening of said highway and we not being able to agree with them as to the amount of such damages having applied to them for that purpose and endeavored to make such agreement did at the time of making said order assess the damages which such owners will sustain by reason of the laying out and opening of such highway through these lands as follows to wit: To Jas. Whitehead on Sec. 12 the N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4, Town of Newark we have assessed and hereby award the sum of \$18.00 as such damages.

To Taurns Saberson on the N.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 7 in the Town of Beloit \$25.00
