

ORDER FOR THE DISCONTINUANCE OF A HIGHWAY

The supervisors of the Town of Beloit met at the shop of Thomas McElkenny according to previous notice and being satisfied by the certificate of Edwin Bicknell that notice had been given according to law, proceeded to examine the highway that the petition of Edwin Bicknell and others ask to have discontinued dated 31st of May 1850, and do hereby order that the prayer of the said petition be granted by the discontinuance of the following described highway.

Beginning at the center of the East end of School Street; thence running North 87° East 4 chains to an angle; thence S North 43½° East to the road laid out by the supervisors of said Town 30th of March 1850. Recorded Liber A Folio 120 being also the continuation of Second Street.

To the supervisors of the Town of Beloit in the County of Rock and State of Wisconsin.

The undersigned resident freeholders of the said town and liable to be assessed for highway labor therein, hereby petition and make application to you the said supervisors to lay out a public highway in said town commencing at a point in the angle of the street known and distinguished as Turtle Street where the same is intersected by School Street at the Southwest corner of Block 47 in the Village plat of the Town of Beloit as surveyed by Doolittle, the map and description of which was recorded in the office of Register of Deeds of the County of Rock on the 24th day of September A.D. 1859 and running thence North 34° and 30' East along the line of said Turtle Street adjoining and lying between the public landing and the Western bounds of said Block 47 on said plat, to a point where the same intersects Public Avenue as designated upon said map or plat; thence Easterly along and including said Public Avenue to Prospect Street and that said highway be laid out in exact accordance with and including all of the parts of said Turtle Street and Public Avenue hereby designated according to the courses, distance and width and boundaries of said streets and the blocks and grounds adjoining them as the same are designated on the plat or map referred to:
