C. Fields to a point in the Southport Road in a direct line or nearly so in the discussion of the supervisors with Broad Street said highway or street to be one hundred feet wide.

ORDER FOR HIGHWAY

We the supervisors of the Town of Beloit met agreeable to previous notice at the East end of Broad Street on the ground that was to be examined on the 13th day of October A.D. 1851 at ten o'clock A.M. for the purpose of examining a proposed continuance of Broad Street petitioned for by Edwin Bicknell, S. G. Fisher and five other freeholders of said town and being satisfied from our own knowledge from or that notice had been duly posted and served according to law. Proceeded to examine the proposed route and do hereby order and determine that a highway or street of 15 1/2 links wide be laid on or out and established: Beginning at the East line of Mechanic's Green opposite the head of Broad Street forming a continuance of Broad Street; thence running North 28 1/2 East 215 links to East end of bridge; thence same course 700 links to the center of an highway 100 links wide. The part of road 700 links to be 100 links wide.

ORDER FOR HIGHWAY

We the supervisors of the Town of Beloit met agreeable to previous notice at the Northeast angle of Block 46 on the 15th day of May 1852 at two o'clock P.M. for the purpose of examining a proposed road petitioned for by J. J. Bushnell and three other freeholders of said town. On being satisfied from our knowledge that notice had been duly posted and served according to law. Proposed to proceed to examine said proposed route.

And do hereby order and determine that a highway or street of one chain in width be laid out and established according to the following description to wit: Beginning 5 links West of the Northeast corner of Block 46, the West line of said streets runs thence 7° East of North 8 chains and 40 links; thence 10° East of North and a half chain; thence 47° East of North to the center line of River alley; thence five a half degrees East to the North line of the Village of Beloit; thence 4° West of North to the intersection of said line with the West line of the Janesville River Road, and further we do hereby order and determine that the road now laid through blocks specified in said petition be taken up and also that part of the Janesville road South of said point of intersection, said road to be one chain wide on the East of the above described line.

ORDER FOR PRIVATE HIGHWAY

We the supervisors of the Town of Beloit met agreeable to previous notice at the residence of John Chamberlin in said town on the 22nd day of June A.D. 1852 at nine o'clock A.M. for the purpose of examining a proposed private road petitioned for by John Chamberlin in freeholder of said town and being satisfied from our own knowledge that notice had been duly served according to law. Proceeded to examine the proposed private road and do hereby order and determine that a private highway or road of two rods in width be laid out and established: Beginning in the East and West centerline of the Southwest quarter of Sec. 26, rods farther West than the Southwest corner part of John Chamberlin's door yard; thence running South parallel with the quarter section line 80 rods to highway between Sec's. 20 & 29.
