In consideration of the above described private road John Chamberlin binds himself, his heirs and assigns to pay Mordecai A. Holmes through whose land said road passes the sum of \$25 dollars and also gives said Holmes his heirs and assigns the privilege of having a curve of four rods in width to wit:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Southwest quarter of Section 21 and running West on the East half of the Southeast quarter of Section 20 to some point two rods West of a certain brook which runs across the Southeast quarter of Section 20 in said town, provided said Holmes, his heirs and assigns, shall make and keep in repair all the fence that said line requires so long as the above described private road shall be used as such

To the Supervisors of the Town of Beloit in the County of Rock:

Take notice that an application has been made to E. P. King, Justice of the Peace of the Town of Beloit in the County aforesaid and precept issued by said Justice for a jury to assess and appraise the damages sustained by Mordecai A Holmes by reason of the laying out a private road by you across his land by your order dated 22nd day of June A.D. 1852 and the said jury will appear at my office in said town of Beloit on the 19th day of July 1852 at ten o'clock in the forenoon to assess and appraise the said damages at which time and place you are notified to appear and show cause if why or any damages additional should not be allowed by said jury for the laying of said private road across said land.

We the supervisors of the Town of Beloit met agreeable to previous notice at the residence of Jason W. Briggs on the 6th day of November A.D. 1852 at nine o'clock A.M. for the purpose of examining a proposed road petitioned for by J. W. Briggs and six others - freeholders of said town on being satisfied from our own knowledge that notices had been duly posted and served according to law. Proceeded to examine the proposed route.

And do hereby order and determine that a highway or road of four rods in width be laid out and established according to the following description to wit:

Beginning in a highway on the North line of Section 18 and running South on the line between the East and West halves of the Northwest quarter of said section according to the United States Survey 20 chains to the center of said Northwest quarter; thence South 36° East 7 chains and 42 links; thence South 10° West 24 chains and 39 links to the line between the East and West halves of the Southwest quarter of said section at the center of the North half of said Southwest quarter; thence South on the government line to a highway on the South line of said section 30 chains.
