ORDER FOR HIGHWAY

We the supervisors of the Town of Beloit met agreeably to previous notice at the house of Eleazer Baldwin on the 23rd day of July 1849 for the purpose of examining the route of a road petitioned for by Wm. Shaw and six others - freeholders of said town and having been satisfied that the notices had been duly posted and served according to law by the affidavit of Wm Shaw proceeded to examine the proposed route for said road and do hereby order and determine that a highway of four rods wide be laid out and established. The centerline of which shall be as follows to wit: Beginning at the quarter section post in the East line of Section 6 in said town and running East on the the quarter section line through Section 4 & 5 to the center of the East half of Section 4; thence North 55° East 2150 links to the line between Section 3 and 4; thence South on said section line to center of bridge 250 links; thence South 20° and 20' East in the road from Beloit to Janesville 615 links to the quarter section line of Section 3 at a point 218 links East of the quarter post; thence East on the quarter section lines through Section 1, 2 & 3, to Rock River

We the undersigned supervisors of the Town of Beloit hereby certify that we met agreeably to previous notice at the house of J. G. Winslow on the 15th day of October 1849 at eleven o'clock A.M. and being satisfied that due notice had been given according to law proceeded to examine the route for the alteration of a highway agreeably to the petition of Wm. Alverson and six other freeholders and do hereby order and determine that said alteration shall be as follows to wit: Beginning in the center of the highway North 36° West 16 chains from the Northeast corner of Section 30; thence running North 35° West 7 chains and 20 links; thence North 24° West 21 chains; thence North 12° West 20 chains and 3 links; thence North 20 chains to the South line of Section 18 in the center of the Southeast quarter on the line running East and West; thence North on the West line of the East of the East tier of eighties to the North line of Section 18; thence North the same course 18 chains and 29 links to the center of the Beloit and Madison Road and we further order and determine that all that part of the present road lying between the point of beginning of the above laid road and the Beloit and Madison Road be and is hereby discontinued and taken up.
