

## ORDER FOR HIGHWAY

At a meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Beloit held at the house of Isaac Gilman in said town to consider the matter of the petition of said Gilman and five others - freeholders of said town of erection of a highway: Commencing at the Beloit and Janesville road on quarter section line of Section 10 to a point two rods beyond the center of Section 9; thence North on quarter section line one mile to the road now leading from that point East to Rock River. Said road to be four rods wide, and it appears to the satisfaction of said supervisors that copies of said petition had been posted according to law, the prayer of said petition was granted; and said highway declared erected according to the above description and by an agreement between the parties and said supervisors \$20 to be paid to Isaac F. Gilman and the like to William Show for damages in passing through their land.

AFTON ROAD

To the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Beloit, we the subscribers or habitants of the Town of Beloit do ask your honorable body to lay a public highway commencing at a mound in the line between the Town of Beloit and Rock and the corner of Sections 33 and 34 of the Town of Rock and running Southwardly in a straight course with the North and South line between sections above named till it shall come within two rods of the fence on the East side of the road as it is now traveled on Section 3 in the Town of Beloit; thence bearing West so as to hit the section line between Section 3 and 4 on the bluff opposite Ernest Baldwin's house; thence on said line to the bridge at the creek at the foot of said bluff; thence to intersect with a road now laid to the Village of Beloit and to discontinue the old county road running the bounds (Near) of the road we ask you to lay.

ORDER FOR HIGHWAY

We the supervisors of the Town of Beloit met agreeable to previous notice at the house of Edwin Gibbs on the 3rd day of June 1851 for the purpose of examining the route of a road petitioned for by Edwin Gibbs and fourteen others - freeholders of said town for being satisfied by the oath of John P. Gillman that the notice had been duly posted, I served according to law proceeded to examine the proposed route and do hereby order and determine that a highway of four rods wide by laid out and established the center line of which shall be as follows: Beginning in the center of the highway from Beloit to Janesville on the West side of Rock River at the termination of the alteration made on Monday the 3rd day of June, 1844 (which was at a bridge South and near Est. Baldwin's house) and running North 2° West 6 chains and 15 links to a post bearing South 19½° East 2 chains from the South-east corner of Est. Baldwin's barn; thence North 5¼° East 17 chains 85 links; thence North 1° West 15 chains, 41 links to corner of Section 33 and 34 in Township 2 of Range 12. Variation of needle 6¼° East. Wm. P.
