

ORDER OR ALTERATION OF PART OF A COUNTY ROAD

We the supervisors of the Town of Beloit in the County of Rock and State of Wisconsin do hereby certify that we met agreeable to previous notice on Saturday the 14th day of July A.D. 1855 at the office of Castle and Parker in said town of Beloit to consider the petition of Charles Messer and five other freeholders in said town for the alteration of a grant of a county road in said county of Rock described in said petition; and being satisfied of our own knowledge that the notices required by law had been posted and served according to law, proceeded to examine the route for the alteration of said part of county road agreeable to said petition, and do hereby determine that said alteration shall be as follows to wit: Beginning at the Eastern terminus of Fourth Street in Beloit aforesaid; thence North 77° East and crossing the town line at 38-15/100 chains so that part of said road which is East of a town road running from Second Street to the Milwaukee Road shall connect with and be a continuation of the same county road as now altered through the town of Turtle it being on the 1/16 section line through the Northwest quarter of Section 31.

And we do farther order and determine that said road as herein before altered shall be four rods in width.

We the supervisors of the Town of Beloit do hereby certify that we met agreeable to previous notice on Saturday the 4th day of August, 1855 at the office of Castle and Parker in said town to consider the petition of S. G. Fisher and eleven other freeholders of said town for discontinuing a highway in said town, described in said petition.

And being satisfied by the affidavit of James A. White that the notices required by law had been duly posted and given as required by law proceeded to examine the highway that the said petition of S. G. Fisher and others asks to have discontinued. And do hereby order and determine that the prayer of said petitioners be granted by the discontinuance of the following described highway to wit:

Beginning on the Eastern termination of Broad Street in Beloit; thence South 70° East four and 75/100 chains near or over Mechanic's Square; thence South 65° East 5-81/100 chains where it is supposed to be met by an extension of Race Street. Said highway so discontinued being four rods in width.
