The said quarter line being the center of said highway --- and which highway has been laid out and established according to a order bearing date Oct. 16th, 1860. hereinafter described and annexed. You are therefore each and severally hereby ordered to remove your fences or any obstruction from within the bounds of said highway on or before the tenth day of April next. Whereas upon the application of six freeholders of said Town of Beloit for laying out a highway as follows viz: Beginning at the center of Section 8 in said Town of Beloit running West along the quarter line through Section 8 and 7 to the Beloit and Madison Road. We the undersigned supervisors of the town did on the 16th day of October 1860 proceed to decide upon said application by examination of the proposed route and did determine that and then and there to lay said highway. And we do now order and determine that a highway be the same is hereby laid out as follows to wit:

Beginning at the center of Sec. 8 in the Town of Beloit and running West along the quarter line through Sections 8 and 7 to the Beloit and Madison Road of the width of four rods. Said quarter line being the center of said highway and it is also further ordered that said highway be opened by the owners or occupants of said lands above described by the removal of fences or other obstruction from within the bounds of said highway on or before the tenth day of April next. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands this 24th day of January 1861.
