FENCE VIEWERS REPORT

This is to certify that we J. W. Crist and J. A. Millett duly appointed fence viewers of the Town of Beloit have this day examined the division line between Lafayette Vanantwerp and W. H. H. Eddy and have set off the North half of said line to be built by the said Vanantwerp or the occupant of said farm and the South half to be built by W. H. H. Eddy. And we have also divided the line between W. H. H. Eddy and W. H. Burrows on the South of said lot giving the West half to W. H. Burrows and the East half to W. H. H. Eddy. Said fence is to be built on the South by Eddy and Burrows and the East by Vanantwerp and Eddy fencing off twenty acres on the North of the West fractional quarter of Section 2 of the Town of Beloit. And said fence is to be built in thirty days.

Whereas John Climchy and George Shaw are the owners of land that are adjoining in the said Town of Beloit and a dispute has arisen between them concerning the respective proportions of division fence to be maintained or made by them. Now therefore, we the undersigned fence viewers of the said town do hereby certify that upon application of John Clenchy, we proceeded to examine the premises and that we do determine that said division fence be built as follows: This fence sits ten rods South from the line between Section 4 and Section 9 commencing at the road East of the Millett lot. The said George Shaw is to build and keep in repair the East forty-five rods of said fence and John Clenchy of the second part is to build and keep the West West 35 rods of said fence and the ten rods running South to North on the West side of the Millett lot and keep in repair.
